WHAT IS A WATER NEUTRAL POOL?

A Water Neutral Pool includes at least three key water saving features:







A cover to reduce evaporation, and



A backwash minimisation system to prevent unnecessary water loss

BENEFITS OF A CERTIFIED WATER NEUTRAL POOL?

You will pay less for water, maintenance and pool chemicals. At the same time you will reduce your pool's environmental impact, while enjoying the benefits of a pool.

A Water Neutral Pool can save more than 6,000 litres of water every year, which can be used in toilets, laundries and the garden.

WHAT DO I GET ONCE MY POOL IS CERTIFIED?

Aside from the benefits of lower operating costs and contributing to a sustainable future, Water Neutral Pool owners receive a personalised display certificate and free metal plaque that can be affixed to your home's fence to demonstrate your water-wise credentials.

You can also help to offset the water used in your pool by installing shade sails and wind covers to prevent evaporation, regularly checking for leaks, and never over-filling the pool.
